- Schedule - Enclosed please find the competition schedule.
- Scratches - Due to commitments for judges and awards the scratch deadline for refunds has passed. We will attempt to do level changes on a space available basis only. - Hotel - If you have not made your room reservations please do so immediately. For hotel information please check our website at: www.charlestoncup.com. We ask that all participants please patronize the host hotels and restaurants. In addition to the great prices and services they have gone out of their way to support our sport.
- Meet Site Info - All of the competitions will be held at the North Charleston Convention Center. Please note that there is a daily parking fee of \$4.00
- Team Comp. - If you have not already done so you will need to designate your 3-4 man team members for team competition. You may change your team line-up right up to the start of competition. If you did not designate your team members when you sent in your entry, then your first 4 athletes in that level were selected. Please make sure that you change this line up prior to the start of the competition.
- Credentials - All coaches and gymnasts will receive credentials at check in. Please remind your gymnasts that they will need to show their credentials in order to enter the competition site. All coaches and athletes must have their USAG numbers available at check in. No gymnast or coach will be allowed to enter the competition area without these credentials as required by USAG guidelines. If you did not send in USAG numbers for any of your athletes or coaches with your entry please e-mail them in to us immediately.

- Age Groups All levels of gymnasts are divided into 3 equal age groups (Childrens, Juniors, Seniors) for each session of the Charleston Cup. The only exception to this is in level 2, 3 where there are no age groups.
- Level 2 & 3 South Carolina rules do not allow the giving of placement awards or team competition for level 2 & 3. All level 2 & 3 gymnasts will be given event ribbons as well as an all-around participation medal.
- PREP Rules Charleston Cup uses the Region 8 Prep Rules. These rules are posted on the website under forms.
